COMMUNITY FOOTBALL LEAGUE SUBMISSION FOR FUNDING APPLICATION

The SA Community Football Board has determined that Affiliated Leagues and Clubs are able to make submissions to the CFB for Funding Grants after undertaking certain football programs. The following guidelines will apply.

Priority 1 –SPORTS TRAINERS

SA Community Football Clubs may apply for funding for reimbursement of the costs of Sports Trainers Courses (Level 1 and 2). Travel costs will also be considered for participants who are required to travel by car a total distance of more than 100 km to attend a course and may claim travel costs at the rate of 20 cents/km for every kilometre over 100km. In order to receive any reimbursement the trainer must successfully complete the course.

Priority 2 – COACHING

SA Community Football Clubs may apply for funding for reimbursement of the costs of Level One coaching courses. Travel costs will also be considered for participants who are required to travel by car a total distance of more than 50 km to attend a course, and may claim travel costs at the rate of 20 cents/km for every kilometre over 50km. In order to receive any reimbursement the coach must successfully complete the course.

Priority 3 – JUNIOR CARNIVALS

SA Community Football Leagues may apply for funding to assist them with the costs of competing in a Junior Inter-league Carnival. Areas that will be considered include: -

- Bus travel
- Sports Medical Products

Priority 4 – ADMINISTRATION SUPPORT

SA Community Football Leagues may apply to request funding reimbursement for Programs, Courses or Zone meetings, President Forums etc, which will benefit Football Administration. In particular Leagues and Clubs may apply for funding associated with **Strategic Planning and Club Development** travel costs if people have more than 100km to attend. Travel costs at a rate of 20 cents/km for every kilometre travelled over 100km will apply.

Priority 5 – FOOTBALL GUERNSEYS

Funding for Guernseys is available through the Game Development Department for **Junior Clubs** (Under 17 and below) who introduce **new teams** into a competition. Please note that the reimbursement for Senior jumper costs **will not** be considered. Purchase from one of the SACFL Licensed Suppliers and incorporation the SACFL logo must occur.

The Community Football Board is allocated a budget for submissions for funding. Therefore the amount that is reimbursed in any one year will depend on the number of applications received. Applications will be viewed in priority order as indicated above.

Application can be made on the accompanying form and must reach the offices of the SANFL by no later than 31 August each year.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION

The Regional Football Manager will record and process applications and present to the CFB for approval.

All funds are for reimbursement only, therefore a tax invoice confirming the expenditure must be included with the claim.

Applications for Sports Trainers Course and Football Guernsey reimbursement must be submitted by the Club.

Applications for Junior Carnivals, Administration Support must be submitted by the League.

The decisions of the Community Football Board will be final and binding.

For New Community Football Junior Teams

SANFL GAME DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

The SANFL Game Development Council has allocated funds in the 2011 budget to assist Community Football Junior District and Associations with Resources as outlined below :-

1. Football Guernseys

Only JUNIOR Community Football Club teams that are members of CFB District Leagues / Associations may apply to the SANFL for a subsidy on guernseys for a **new team** entering into a competition in their League / Association. To be eligible teams must adhere to the following conditions :-

- The Coach of the team must have Coach Accreditation. Documentation of the Accreditation will be required
- The Community Football Club will pay for the full set of guernseys (22) and at the completion of the season, provided the team has played in a competition, will receive the subsidy. A copy of the receipt is to be attached to the application form.
- The Affiliated League Club is playing children in age groups that are compliant with the AFL Next Generation Australian Football Match Policy.

Teams that qualify for the subsidy are eligible to receive the following :

- A subsidy up to 50% of the cost of a new set of guernseys (22)
- Guernseys must include the SACFL Logo and be purchased from one of our Licensed Suppliers.

GENERAL INFORMATION

A sub committee of the SANFL Game Development Council will receive and study all submissions and make recommendations to the Game Development Council on the allocation of funds and subsidies.

Applications can be made on the accompanying form and must be returned to the SANFL Office on or before 31st August, 2011.

CONDITIONS

The following conditions for applications will apply.

1. All applications are to be submitted via the League / Association with whom the Club is associated.
2. Submissions will not be accepted unless endorsement is granted by the League / Association.
3. Receipts and verification of all costs must be produced.
4. Applications will not be received **after August 31.**
